- 5. Music will be pre-recorded; at a later time, not yet determined, our Music Director David Larstein will be in the sanctuary for a live prelude and postlude.
- 6. Hymnals have been removed; readings and the words to songs will be on the two large flat screens at the front of the sanctuary.
- 7. Passing the Peace will be socially distanced.
- 8. After worship, and after any sharing in the pews, we encourage you to gather in the courtyard for further conversation, rather than at the back of the sanctuary.
- 9. To protect others and yourselves, please do not attend in person if you are not feeling well, have a fever, cough, or new symptoms of Covid-19. Be sensitive to evaluating your own health situation and the needs of others.
